

SUGGESTIONS FOR HOME LEARNING – TERMS 5 & 6 EXPEDITIONS

Communication & My Voice

- Keep a diary of activities, events, and learning whilst at home.
- Enjoy some stories about journeys (read books or watch films/documentaries). Record if you like or don't like the story.
- Practise your phonics and writing through activities or games.
- Phonics/word games, e.g. eye spy, hangman, bingo, junior scrabble, snap.

Curious Thinkers

- Learn to give and follow directions; left, right, forward, backwards, up, down.
- Give, write or follow directions around your home, garden or to get from one place to another or for toys.
- Sequence events in the day. What time do main events happen and can you read these times on a clock?
- How long does it take to do an activity, or how many can you complete in a minute, e.g. jumps, stack of bricks, etc.
- Can you measure the length of objects? You could use bricks or parts of your body to measure.
- Find out about any animals that go on journeys (linked to the films, stories and documentaries you enjoy).
- Number rhymes and games, e.g. board games, dominoes, snap.

Get Creative

- Draw or colour pictures linked to the stories or different places.
- Listen to music from different places and record what you like and don't like about it.

- Do something active each day, e.g. go for a walk, use your Wii or another similar game system, Joe Wicks daily PE lesson (online), cosmic yoga (online), Go Noodle songs (online).
- Think of something you have enjoyed or something good that happens each day. (You could record this in your diary each day)

Life & Living

- Help with or do some baking/cooking.
- Find how some foods are grown or made, such as the ones you eat at home.
- Record what new things you try or achieve in your diary.
- Learn about keeping safe on the internet.

My World

- Find out about the weather in different places. How does the weather vary during the year?
- Look for signs of spring. Record what you see, where and when.
- What religions do people follow in the places in your stories? Find out about these religions – where and when do they worship, do they go on journeys (or pilgrimages)?
