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Communication & My Voice

- Read books about Great Expeditions eg. Gulliver's Travels, Grandpa's Great Escape
Non Fiction – Hannibal and his elephants
- Watch films about Expeditions made by both animals and humans

- Play games which involve giving and following directions eg make a simple obstacle course and give directions on how to get through
